## **A LIST NOLLYWOOD ACTRESS: STEPHANIE OKEREKE'S COMPANY DEL-YORK INTERNATIONAL BRINGS THE NEW YORK FILM ACADEMY TO NIGERIA.**

In recognition of the challenges facing Nigeria's Film industry, Del-York international, (with support from the Ministry of Information), has entered into an agreement with the world's most prestigious film-making Academy, the New York Film Academy (NYFA) to bring the Academy's world-class training courses, facilities and tutors to Abuja Nigeria on February 1<sup>st</sup> 2010. Registrations for classes have begun and will end on December 20th 2009. Orientation for the program will be held from January 18th to the 29th of 2010 at the prestigious Public Service Institute of Nigeria, Abuja. Designed for a new generation of film makers, screen writers, actors, producers, copy writers, creative directors and animators who share a passion for motion pictures, the training model allows all participants to achieve more in less time than any other University, Institute or School in the world. Each student will conceive, produce, direct and edit a new media project in one week.

Del-York will be using a prime facility in Victoria Island Lagos where students will be accommodated in small classes of 20 students per classroom.

The Film School at the New York Film Academy was founded in 1992 on a belief that a top quality education in filmmaking should be accessible to anyone with the drive and ambition to make films. NYFA also opened Film Academies at Universal Studios in Los Angeles and London UK, England. Today, little more than a decade after the first students graduated, the New York Film Academy is considered one of the most prominent fixtures of film education in the world.
